### Product Name: LR260 i-Note

The LR260 i-Note from Animation Technologies is an embedded system based on Intel CPU PXA255 and Microsoft OS WinCE.net which functions as a powerful multimedia IA device. The LR260 i-Note works on an Ethernet network environment and supports a modem dial-up. By supporting WinCE.net OS, the LR260 i-Note allows users to work with a current Window PC on Internet environment.

The LR260 has a built-in RJ45 Ethernet port, supporting up-link to either a router or an ADSL modem to WAN connection. It is not only a network client, but also a server. The LR260 i-Note allows for HTTP server and FTP server configurations. Both server configurations support PPP/PPPoE or TCP/IP, as well as SIP for VoIP capability. All the client-server based APs, such as e-mail sending/receiving, web browsing, VoIP phone, videophone, and media player applications can be easily adopted on the networking function provided by the i-Note.

The LR260 gives all the capabilities of other multi-media devices. It can play MP3 music files from either the Internet or through an external CF/SD storage slot. It can function as a digital photo viewer for DSCs, and is capable of manual or auto slide shows of the digital pictures. The LR260 supports Microsoft Media Player technology for Internet connectivity. This gives users MPEG 1, MPEG 4 and WMA file playback.

The i-Note has various Windows application programs as well, coming from its WinCE.net OS utilities. Functions such as e-mail sending/receiving, web browser, MS Word file reading, MS Excel file reading, PDF file reading, and PowerPoint file reading can be supported on this platform.

The LR260 provides several connectivity options. It has built-in IrDA and USB 1.1 client parts, which perform connectivity with a PC via Active Sync. The CF/SD slot is supported for data storage. End users can use this slot as storage for e-mail, MP3s, and other types of data. A remote receiver has been built-in to support remote control capability. The end users can connect the LR260 with a TV, and by utilizing the video-out port and the remote control, they can operate the LR260 on the big screen. The IR receiver also supports remote keyboard/mouse/joy sticker for WinCE.net games.
